Summary: October 21, 2022, the San Carlos Forest Resources Program, Wildland Prescribed Fire personnel begin their Prescribed Burn operations in the Anderson Flat location, making steady progress in Anderson Flat Prescribed Burn Unit 1 and completed a total 237 acres. The following shift of October 22, 2022, the Wildland fire resources continued ignition operations and made steady progress and completed Prescribed Burn Unit 1 and moving onto Prescribed Burn Unit 2. Completing a total of 187 acres for the days operational shift. **Overall total acres accomplished is 424 acres** in the Anderson Flat Prescribed Burn Unit. (See Map).

However, for today, October 23, 2022, operational shift there is a 50% chance of showers. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 50. West southwest winds 13-16 MPH, with gust as high as 29 MPH. Putting the Anderson Flat Broadcast Prescribed Burn out of favorable conditions. Therefore, the Wildland fire personnel will remain in monitor status for the remainder of today's operational shift, until weather conditions improve and allow for Prescribed Burning operations to continue. No road closures or restrictions apply, prescribed burn signs will remain set up along the roadway and at intersections to notify the public of Prescribed Burn activity, and Wildfire personnel that continue to monitor and patrol the roads/trail systems adjacent to the Anderson Flat Broadcast Prescribed Burn Units.

The Operational shift may vary daily due to weather conditions and resource needs.
