Summary:

Yesterday's operational shift began on October 15, 2022, in the Anderson Flat location (See Map). The San Carlos wildland prescribed fire personnel continued their operational shift in Prescribed burn unit, **AF06**, and **AF05** completing a total of 215 Acres in the Anderson Flat Pile Burn location. Expected incoming Showers and Thunderstorms after occurred, along with further Precipitation in the Anderson Flat location. Reducing the limited amount of time to conduct Prescribed burning for their operational shift. Furthermore, due to the down pour of rain, and an overnight chance of 80% precipitation.

Will continue in to today, on October 16, 2022, Expected showers and thunderstorms. High near 60. Calm winds becoming south around 6 mph. Chance of precipitation is 80%, and anticipated to occur in the Anderson Flat location, for today's operational shift. 7-Day Forecast 33.54N 109.52W (weather.gov).

Heavy rainfall, expected showers, and thunderstorms remain evident. The Wildland Prescribed fire personnel will begin monitoring the Anderson Flat Pile Prescribed burn unit for today's operational shift, and until current rainy Weather conditions subside. Anderson Flat Pile Burn Unit, will remain in monitor status until further notice

There are no road closures or restrictions, prescribed burn signs will remain set up along the roadway and at intersections to notify the public of Prescribed fire personnel that continue to monitor the fire activity and patrol the roads/trail systems adjacent to the Anderson Flat Pile Prescribed Burn Unit.

Please drive with caution if traveling in the vicinity of the prescribed burn. Firefighters and Public safety are always our number one priority.
